4 reasons

1. It should be easy to be a customer

We are making it simpler for most customers to own a .dk domain name. One provider. One invoice.

2. Same model as other registries

International harmonization ensures continued high competition.

3. Free up resources at Punktum dk

This will free up resources at Punktum dk, which will be used for further initiatives aimed at keeping the .dk zone as secure and free from misuse as possible.

4. Increased requirements to registrars

Requirements that can provide registrants with a professional service and contribute to making the .dk zone as secure as possible.



We must deal with the concerns

Rising prices

- There is no evidence that prices will rise. They will only rise if competition disappears.
- Foreign players currently opt out of the .dk zone because it is too costly to work with .dk due to the two existing models.
- By eliminating one model, this barrier is removed, and it may lead to intensified competition because customers will be able to purchase a .dk domain name from more providers.
- Competitive pressure will keep prices down. This is the experience gained from other areas.

Registrant protection

- We will retain the option for registrants to move in and out of registrar management, and to exit financially lockedin situations.
- Furthermore, we will continue to offer the option for direct restoration with us.

High security on .dk domain names risks being lowered

- We maintain data control and ID verification as activities we perform, if they are not carried out in a similar manner by others.
- We are tightening the requirements for registrars regarding their own security and their ability to deliver secure solutions to their customers.
- We maintain and develop models to create incentives for registrars to make the .dk zone as secure as possible.



Macro timeline

2025

Preparation of model and transition.

24.9 communication to registrars and invitation to registrar meetings in October 2025 as well as offer of individual meeting.

Early October general communication to registrants.

21 and 23 October Registrar meetings.

2026

1.1.2026 announcement of end of registration of domain names with duration longer than 1 year.

January – May. Production of selection features in own systems.

April. New registrar contract I is sent to registrars. Information about new requirements for registrars in the registrar contract II with phasing in as of 1 July 2027.

1.7.2026 start of transition period.

This means end of new registration of registrant-managed domain names and end of registration and renewal of domain names with duration longer than 1 year. (Information to registrants about choosing a registrar starts from here).

2027

1.7.2027 New registrar contract II in effect.

2028

30.6.2028 end of transitional arrangement.

This means that a decision must be made on what to do with the remaining portfolio

October 1, 2026.

Draft of new registrar contract II, with stricter requirements for registrars, is sent to registrars for technical review

January 1, 2027

Issue of registrar contract II with stricter requirements for registrars. Must be signed no later than June 30, 2027.

July 2027

Final dealer contract II enters into force

TERMS AND CONDITIONS I

April 1, 2026

Notification of new terms of use, phasing in new administration model.

July 1, 2026

New terms come into effect.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS II

From July 1, 2028

New terms that completely phase out registrant management.

Have sale and administration of domains as an integrated part of their business

So, you can offer the products that .dk domain customers expect, and where the registrar has basic and necessary knowledge of DNS, the domain ecosystem, and good domain name practice.

Because the .dk domain customers must have competent advice and access to necessary products.

- 1. The Registrar must be able to document knowledge of the following subjects:
 - Knowledge of good domain name practice
 - Knowledge of basic DNS
 - Knowledge of the domain ecosystem
 - Familiarity with Punktum dk's terms and procedures
- 2. The Registrar must be able to offer and administer name services themselves or via a re-seller.
- 3. Familiarity and routine with standard domain handling operations such as registration, transfer between registrars, termination, transfer of ownership, renewal, and redemption of domain names.
- 4. Registrars must run their business with the sale of domains in mind.
- 5. All Registrars must appear on the published list of registrars with the specified profile information. To guide customers. This refers to the profile information Punktum dk makes public, such as contact details, service area.

Professional Customer Service

Provide a professional customer experience and deliver the service that customers expect. **Because** we require that .dk domain customers receive professional and competent handling.

- 1. The Registrar must offer the registrant assistance with the management of their domain, and clearly state opening hours and contact channels.
- 2. The Registrar must offer: Restore of suspended domains for their own customers. Execution of registrar transfers by providing the Auth-ID to the registrant, regardless of the reason and without undue delay.
- 3. A Registrar may use a re-seller, and when doing so, it is the Registrar's responsibility to ensure that the reseller complies with the requirements set for the Registrar.
- 4. Regarding .dk domains, the Registrar must ensure that the communication of procedures, prices, and terms towards the registrant is clear, so that the registrant can easily familiarize themselves with this information. Furthermore, company information must be clearly displayed on the Registrar's website.



Secure Systems and Secure Solutions

Have secure systems and be able to deliver secure solutions to .dk domain customers.

Comply with all applicable legislation at any given time, as well as Punktum dk's requirements for security measures and security solutions for customers.

Because the security of registrars and registrants must be guaranteed, along with the security of the users of .dk domains.

- 1. The Registrar must support:
 - Multi-factor authentication on any self-service solution.
 - A public channel for receiving abuse notifications.
 - Interaction with Punktum dk's abuse contact.
- 2. The Registrar must be able to deliver DNSSEC signing for domain names.
- 3. The Registrar must work with their own fundamental security in systems and organization, as well as security awareness.

Ability to Work Digitally

Possess a technical infrastructure that can handle the automated registration, renewal, and transfer of domain names through Punktum dk's machine interface.

Because we desire the most effective form of collaboration so that domain registration can occur as simply and efficiently as possible.

- 1. Registrars must use Punktum dk's EPP interface (or any other API designated later) for data exchange with Punktum dk to ensure traceability and consistency in data, and the highest possible security during domain registration and administration.
- 2. Registrars must continuously keep their own profile and contact data updated so that it remains correct in Punktum dk's systems at all times.
- 3. The Registrar must not unnecessarily burden Punktum dk's systems with excessive traffic.


Registrars who are cooperative and committed

BUT we do NOT require that. We find another way to handle it.








The consequence ladder

If you are a registrar now but do not offer registrar management now

- Therefore, effective July 1, 2026, you must be able to offer Registrar Management to your new customers.
- You will no longer be able to sell new domains with a validity period longer than 1 year.
- From July 1, 2028, you must be compliant with the new requirements set for registrars (refer to the previous review).



Registrants

4. Managing a Domain Name on behalf of a Registrant

4.1 Registrar may in agreement with a Registrant assist in managing a Domain Name in one of two possible ways:

1. By agreement with Registrar the Registrant authorizes Registrar to take certain actions on behalf of the Registrant (hereinafter "Registrar Management"), which collectively include:

- Make payments to Punktum dk in connection with a conclusion of an agreement on the
 right of use to a Domain Name and the renewal and extension thereof, and with a
 restoration of a Domain Name, which has been suspended, where this is possible
 according to Terms and conditions for the right of use to a .dk domain name.
- Update the Registrant's contact information: Email address, telephone and telefax number and specified contact person if the Registrant is resident in Denmark and in addition postal address if the Registrant is resident outside Denmark.
- Manage name servers: Secure connection of at least two authoritative name servers, change name servers, attend to security measures, including about DNSSEC, register name servers under the Domain Name and optionally provide name server service.
- · Carry out a name transfer of a Domain Name.
- . Terminate the Registrant's agreement on the right of use to the Domain Name.

Registrar must inform Punktum dk in the manner specified by Punktum dk of changes to the Registrant's contact information and the registration period of the Domain name when such changes occur.

- 2. The Registrant may take certain actions himself to manage the right of use to a Domain Name or by agreement let Registrar assist (hereinafter "Registrant Management"). This assistance includes the following:
 - Registrar may be appointed billing contact for the Registrant's Domain Name, which
 means that Punktum dk issues invoices to Registrar.
 - Registrar may be appointed proxy for the Registrant to act on behalf of the Registrant to a
 limited extent, which includes: Initiate change of name servers, attend to security
 measures, including about DNSSEC, change the registration period for a Domain Name,
 replace the billing contact for the Registrant's Domain Name etc.
 - · Provide name server service and attend to security measures, including DNSSEC.

The billing contact's and the proxy's options to act on behalf of the Registrant, cf. section 4.1, no. 2, are described in more details on Punktum dk's website.

- 4.2 With an agreement pursuant to section 4.1 Registrar must ensure the existence of specific, informed, explicit, and verifiable consent from a Registrant.
- 4.3 Prior to obtaining consent, cf. section 4.2., Registrar must ensure that the Registrant is clearly and unambiguously presented with a text approved by Punktum dk, explaining the following:
 - The Registrant's right to Registrar Management, including what Registrant Management means, and how the Registrant's consent to this can be revoked by using the IT system provided by Punktum dk.
 - The Registrant's right to appoint Registrar billing contact and proxy for the Registrant, including what this means, and how the Registrant's consent to this can be revoked by using the IT system provided by Punktum dk.

4. Managing a Domain Name on behalf of a Registrant

4.1 Registrar may in agreement with a Registrant assist in managing a Domain Name in one of two possible ways:

- Make payments to Punktum dk in connection with a conclusion of an agreement on the
 right of use to a Domain Name and the renewal and extension thereof, and with a
 restoration of a Domain Name, which has been suspended, where this is possible
 according to Terms and conditions for the right of use to a .dk domain name.
- Update the Registrant's contact information: Email address, telephone and telefax number and specified contact person if the Registrant is resident in Denmark and in addition postal address if the Registrant is resident outside Denmark.
- Manage name servers: Secure connection of at least two authoritative name servers, change name servers, attend to security measures, including about DNSSEC, register name servers under the Domain Name and optionally provide name server service.
- · Carry out a name transfer of a Domain Name.
- Terminate the Registrant's agreement on the right of use to the Domain Name.

Registrar must inform Punktum dk in the manner specified by Punktum dk of changes to the Registrant's contact information and the registration period of the Domain name when such changes occur.

4.2 With an agreement pursuant to section 4.1 Registrar must ensure the existence of specific, informed, explicit, and verifiable consent from a Registrant.



What about those registrants who are not registrar managed on July 1, 2028?

There are several models.

It will be a decision for the Punktum dk board.

No decision has been made. There are no preferences for the final choice.

MODEL 1:

Registrant-managed domains are transferred to the registrar who operates the name service for the registrant (to the extent that they can be identified) For those for which a potential registrar cannot be identified, a concrete solution is found, e.g. after a smaller tender or similar.

MODEL 2:

The remaining group of registrant-managed domains is sought to be sold to a potentially interested registrar and is then transferred to this registrar.
